### VERNON L. SINGLETON TO RECEIVE 1992 ASEV MERIT AWARD



Vernon L. Singleton, Professor Emeritus of the University of California, Davis, has been selected as the 1992 recipient of the ASEV Merit Award.

The Merit Award is the American Society for Enology and Viticulture's most prestigious honor. It is awarded annually to an outstanding individual who has made significant contributions to the wine and grape industry and to the Society. The Merit Award will be presented to Dr. Singleton at the 43rd ASEV Annual Meeting to be held June 25-27 at Bally's Casino Resort in Reno, Nevada.

Dr. Singleton has been employed by the University of California since 1958. He is a Professor Emeritus of Enology, having retired in 1991. His research focused on natural phenols, oxidation reactions, and wine quality as affected by aging.

He has published over 170 scientific or technical papers, books, patents and reviews. In 1987, he received a Distinguished Teaching Award from the Davis Division of the Academic Senate, University of California, Davis. Dr. Singleton received his Ph.D. in Protein Biochemistry from Purdue University in 1951 and was awarded a D.Sc. from the University of Stellenbosch, South Africa, 1983. He is a member of the American Chemical Society, Institute of Food Technologists and Society of Wine Educators (charter instructor). He served as a member of the Advisory Committee for California State Fair Wine Judging from 1985-1991.

Dr. Singleton served as the President of The American Society for Enology and Viticulture in 1975-1976 and Secretary-Treasurer from 1969-73. He served as an Abstract Editor for the American Journal of Enology and Viticulture from 1959-1973. In 1986, he was selected as the ASEV Honorary Research Lecturer and received the Best Enology Paper Award.

The Merit Award will be awarded to Dr. Singleton at the Annual Meeting following his talk on "Wine and Enology - Status and Outlook." We invite you to join us in Reno to honor Dr. Singleton.
